SPEAKERS AND ENTERTAINERS

GREENBRIER VALLEY THEATRE

Greenbrier Valley Theatre is a live-performance theatre and much more. GVT is involved in all aspects of the arts and humanities, with people of all ages. From its 1966 productions in a tent alongside the Greenbrier River to Actor's Equity affiliation in a state-of-the-art facility in downtown Lewisburg. The Greenbrier Valley Theatre has adhered to the founders' concept: quality live theatre centered around a core of professional actors and directors with opportunities for members of the community to learn stagecraft. In March 2006 GVT became West Virginia's Official Year-Round Professional Theatre.

BOBBY LILLY

Bobby Lilly, a native of Narrows, Virginia, has been entertaining audiences throughout the New River Valley and surrounding areas for nearly thirty-five years. He is an Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney in Pulaski County and an active member and past-President of the Jim Murphy Ring of the International Brotherhood of Magicians in Roanoke, Virginia. His unique form of twisted entertainment adds a magical and festive air to numerous special events for Greenbrier guests throughout the year.

MIDLAND TRAIL HIGH SCHOOL DANCE TEAM

The Midland Trail High School Dance Team performs the halftime show for the MTHS Boys and Girls basketball games, area colleges, and various community events. The team also competes in Regional, State, and National Competitions. In the past 12 years, the team has won over 15 Regional and State Championships, and brought home eight National Champion Titles. The team is coached by Tera Chappell and Rhonda Chuyka.

PAINT SAVVY

Founded in 2007, Paint Savvy is one of North Carolina's premier family entertainment companies. Paint Savvy's signature service, High Quality Professional Face Painting, has been featured by notable clients including Animal Planet, Duke University, University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, Glaxo and others. Paint Savvy artist, Lisa Yu trains the Paint Savvy staff on painting technique, hygiene and customer care on a regular basis and the results have been evident with the fine reputation associated with Paint Savvy. Lisa Yu has also competed at an international level in face and body painting competitions. Awards include multiple 1st place finishes as well as a notable "Perfect Score" placement in 2007 signifying unanimous 1st place placement from all judges.

PAIGE AND JEFF TRENT

Jeff has been dancing ballroom and Latin for 20 years. He has competed professionally in both Smooth and Rhythm divisions. He is a certified dance director and currently owns and directs the Fred Astaire Dance Studio in Winston Salem, North Carolina. She has competed professionally in both Rhythm and Smooth divisions and currently manages the FADS in Winston-Salem. WEST VIRGINIA UNIVERSITY PUPPET MOBILE UNDER THE DIRECTION OF JOANN SPENCER SEIGRIST

Joann Spencer Seigrist is a Professor of Theatre at West Virginia University where she directs intensive studies in puppetry and children's theatre and is the Director of the WVU Puppet Mobile. Over the years, this talented group of West Virginia University students has entertained children of all ages with their imaginative performances. Greenbrier audiences have enjoyed performances by the Puppet Mobile for 25 years. As part of the "green" movement, their Easter performance is titled "The Mirror Man."

CHAD ZAKAIB

Chad Zakaib's love of wine drew him to Jefferson Vineyards in 2003. With prior experience in national news media, he brings a broad management perspective with emphasis on operational efficiencies, risk management, marketing, advertising and brand development. As a leader in the regional and statewide industries, he also works on economic development issues, legislative affairs and wine tourism development. He has been a board member of the Virginia Food and Wine Society and is a founding member of the Wine Guild of Charlottesville. Zakaib has served on the legislative committee of the Virginia Wineries Association. He currently acts a Marketing Committee Chair for the Monticello Wine Trail and is on the advisory Board of Flavor! Magazine. Zakaib considers his role at Jefferson Vineyards as one of stewardship over Thomas Jefferson's historic vineyards. Located adjacent to Monticello, these lands were cultivated by Filippo Mazzei under Jefferson's direction in the 1770s. The estate's current owners reside in Mazzei's restored mansion, Colle, which is on the National Register of Historic Places. Zakaib is a native of Richmond, graduate of St. Christopher's School and The University of Virginia, husband and father of two.
