




Cheesecake at the Greenbrier

A Recipe from America's Resort™

GRAHAM CRUST

1 cup Graham Cracker Crumbs
2 tbs Sugar
2 tbs Butter, melted

CHEESECAKE FILLING

3 packages (8 ounces each) Cream
Cheese, softened.
1 cup sugar
1 cup (8 ounces) Sour Cream
2 tbs AP Flour
2 tsp Vanilla Extract
4 large Eggs, lightly beaten
1 Orange zested



GRAHAM CRUST:

Paddle all together until butter is fully incorporated.
Press into the bottom of the greased mold. Bake at
350°f for about 10 minutes.

CHEESECAKE FILLING:

In large bowl, beat cream cheese and sugar until
smooth. Beat in sour cream, flour, zest and vanilla.
Add eggs on low speed until combined. Pour over
crust.

Bake at 350° for 40-45 minutes or until center is set.
Cool for one hour and refrigerate overnight.

TO FINISH:

Top with fresh strawberries and whipped cream
1 cup cold Heavy Cream
2 tbs Sugar
½ tsp Vanilla

An evening at Café Carleton is sure to deliver an unforgettable cabaret experience where live entertainment pairs perfectly with after-dinner drinks to create a warm and welcoming environment to round out your evening ventures.

Open Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights from 5:00pm until midnight, Café Carleton offers the finest in premium wines and spirits curated from the most prestigious distilleries and wineries from around the world. Bottles of wines from regions such as Chateauneuf-du-Pape are served alongside aged high-end brown liquors, traditional Bavarian ales from the world's oldest breweries and hand-crafted infusions.



"A trip to Café Carleton is a magnificent experience that stimulates all of the senses and provides the perfect after-dinner entertainment," said The Greenbrier Director of Spirits and Casual Dining, Mike Deskins. "The cocktail and wine selection at Café Carleton is designed to be the finest in the world and please the most discerning palate."

To fully appreciate the beauty and flavors inside Café Carleton, I recently made a trip to sample some of the signature cocktails and enjoy the cabaret.

My first drink was a martini, prepared table side, as is any drink at Cafe Carleton made with clear alcohol. The expert servers bring the cart, filled with all of the necessary ingredients for the perfect cocktail, right to the table, giving the guest the option of customizing any drink to meet his or her preference.

The martini was the perfect starter, but it was the theatre of watching the preparation that made the experience so unique. That same theatre extended a table side absinthe fountain. Watching the chilled ice water drip drop-by-drop over a sugar cube to combine with the absinthe for a unique flavor similar to liquorish, was an extraordinary culinary experience.

Not all of the offerings at Café Carleton are served table side, though, so it was time to head to the bar to sample some of the opulent brown liquor offerings and hand-crafted infusions.

There, Deskins explained a little more about some of Café Carleton's signature cocktails, crafted with house-made spirit infusions. Those unique infusions include Red Cherry-Infused Old Forester 100, Banana Nut-Infused Sailor Jerry Spiced Rum, Kenyan Coffee Bean-Infused Finlandia Vodka, Jalapeno and Ginger-Infused Casmigos Tequilla and Thyme and Citrus-Infused Aviation Gin.

All of those spirits - carefully selected by the beverage team and crafted with an unequalled attention to detail - can be ordered straight or in any cocktail. These signature drinks, concocted to create the perfect experience for the refined cocktail connoisseur, stole the show.

First on the list of signature cocktails was the Smoking Gun, which is an experience you have to witness to understand. The process started by pouring Woodford Reserve Bourbon into a decanter. Deskins then put apple wood chips into a special smoker, and as he torched the chips, the smoke ran from a tube into the decanter to give the bourbon a unique smoky flavor, before it was poured over ice into a mule mug. The aroma that filled the room immediately invigorated the senses,





but that was nothing compared to the sensation on my palate when the smoky bourbon was blended with fresh lime juice and blood orange liqueur, then topped with Ginger Beer and garnished with a lime twist.

The Bejeweled is another signature cocktail, made with the thyme and citrus-infused gin. It is shaken with chartreuse, Luxardo syrup and fresh lime and served with a twist of lime in a martini glass. This was also a delectable drink, and I was surprised with how much I enjoyed the thyme flavor infused with the otherwise sweet liquid.

The Tequila Nightingale followed on the sample list, featuring the ginger and jalapeno-infused tequila. Café Carleton's own twist on a Collins also included fresh lemon and ginger simple syrup, and it was served on the rocks with tonic floated on top. The warm taste of this cocktail created an indescribable sensation upon touching my lips.

Beginning at 8:00pm each evening, The Greenbrier Springhouse Entertainers fill Café Carleton with live piano



music and show tunes. The music from the elegantly-dressed entertainers permeated every corner of the room, and their expertly-trained voices had every guest tapping his or her toes or singing along.

“These entertainers are unbelievably talented,” said The Greenbrier Director of Entertainment Jeff Bryant. “The performances at Café Carleton are integral part of the special experience offered for after-dinner entertainment.”

With amazing drinks on the table, talented performers an arms-length away and a room filled with the refined guests of America’s Resort, it was time to complete my evening with a cheese and charcuterie platter. Other menu offerings include caviar service and oysters on the half shell.

“It’s a great place to come and relax and have a craft cocktail made in front of you,” said Deskins. “It’s is a contemporary speakeasy-type feel and we invite all our guests to discover the Café Carleton experience.

“It’s also a terrific spot for groups to buy out to entertain clients or hold company celebrations.”

But were you aware that those legendary Greenbrier sporting adventures are also available when The Old White TPC and the Har-Tru outdoor courts are covered in a blanket of snow?



When it comes to golf, the TruGolf Indoor Simulator provides the perfect opportunity for instruction or entertainment.

With virtual simulations of more than 85 golf courses and 36 modes of play, the simulator gives friends and colleagues a chance to fulfill the need for competition and camaraderie, with a match just like one they would play on The Old White TPC or The Meadows. With food and drink available for purchase and various modes of game play outside of a traditional round, the simulator can also provide a different style of entertainment for a recreational golfer that can't be found on the course.

"Whether you want to play a round at Pebble Beach or compete in an arcade-style game with targets and points, our TruGolf Simulator has you covered," said The Greenbrier Director of Golf Instruction Billy Winters,

who runs the simulator during the winter. "The graphics are amazing, and the simulator is incredibly accurate and realistic. Our guests often make an outing of it with friends, food and drink, and the experience is one to remember."

For the serious golfer determined to keep his or her game in shape, the TruGolf Simulator is also an incredible teaching tool. The TruTrack analyzer provides precise feedback about where the golfer is hitting the ball, how hard it is being hit and other information about ball flight and club head positioning that will help improve every facet of the swing. These tools, paired with the knowledge and experience from Winters, who was named the top instructor in West Virginia by Golf Digest for 2017-18, make for a unique lesson that will get your game in shape for the spring and summer.

"The data that the system provides is incredible," said Winters. "It gives immediate feedback on the swing that helps me make suggestions for improvement."

A little cold weather does nothing to stop the tennis activity at The Greenbrier, as five Deco-Turf indoor courts, a modern pro shop and locker room facilities make for an inviting indoor option.

The indoor courts – which have hosted the likes of Venus Williams, Serena Williams, Pete Sampras, John McEnroe and other tennis greats – can be reserved for \$46 per hour. Rackets can be rented for \$10 a day, and a ball machine can be reserved for \$54 an hour, giving the player every opportunity to work on his or her game with or without a partner.

“There aren’t many resorts around the country that offer the incredible indoor opportunities that we’re able to provide,” said Head Tennis Professional Jennifer Tuckwiller. “The courts are fantastic and provide a great place for a match when the weather turns cold.”

In May of 2018, a new tradition was started at The Greenbrier when America's Resort hosted The Greenbrier Concours d'Elegance for the first time. 
